
As has been my custom, I am very pleased to be swearing in two permanent full time police officers and one permanent full time firefighter at this meeting.





Dear Honorable Members:


The City of North Adams has been operating a Transfer Station that services all of Northern Berkshire County. Over the last two years the Administration has been examining issues and working with the Department of Environmental Protection in order to have a fully permitted Transfer Station.

The improvements needed at the Transfer Station are expected to cost no more than \$65,000. The Transfer Station building is in need of repairs to the structural steel and to the sheathing. It is estimated that these repairs will cost \$35,000. Another item, that is a requirement of our permit, is a hard packed surface for the area used for brush dumping. This area needs to be cleaned, regraded, berms built and millings spread and rolled into that area. The cost for this would not exceed \$15,000. We are also interested in making repairs to the sheathing on the recycle building that would cost approximately \$15,000.

I respectfully request the adoption of the accompanying Order.


