

Dog License

The North Adams City Clerk issues yearly licenses to individuals who own or keep a dog in the City of North Adams. Licenses are issued yearly beginning **January 1st**.

How to License

To obtain a yearly license an owner must provide a valid anti-rabies vaccination certificate and a **\$20.00** fee for male or female dogs. A yearly fee of **\$8.00** is charged to owners who provide a veterinarian's certificate of spaying or neutering.

You may license your dog by any of the following methods:

1. Visit the City Clerk's Office during office hours; Monday-Friday 8:00am to 4:30pm.
2. Mail with payment.

TO LICENSE YOUR DOG BY MAIL

The licensing period runs from January 1st

1. Completed application (see below).
2. Self-addressed stamped envelope for returning of license and tags. Postage needed for the self-addressed envelope: for one dog license affix one stamp; for two or three dog licenses affix two stamps. Kennel licenses are required for anyone owning four or more dogs. Please contact the City Clerk's Office for more information on Kennel Licenses.
3. Check payable to the City of North Adams – **FEES:**

Male/Female	\$20.00
Neutered Male	\$ 8.00
Spayed Female	\$ 8.00

If this is a new dog OR if your dog's rabies vaccination has expired, please provide:

1. Proof of current rabies vaccination showing the expiration date (documentation from your vet).
2. Proof of spay or neuter (documentation from your vet)
