Mayor Alcombright:

I am writing to request that the City of North Adams allow an additional sewer hookup for Raymond and Jeanne Mouthrop, for their property located at 162 Cross Road.

A recent Title V inspection by the Clarksburg Board of Health and an engineer hired by the Mouthrops revealed a failed system, and a percolation test for a new system failed. The board of Health elected not to issue a variance to allow for a replacement system as the property is within 75 feet of an abutter's water well and there is access to the North Adams Sewer line along Cross Roads.

The Town of Clarksburg is in agreement that this would be the best possible solution and would be in compliance with the sewer regulations of the Town.



Dear Honorable Members:

I am writing to ask that the City Council transfer \$10,600 from the Reserve Account to R & M Services Buildings Account in order to pay for the cost of demolition of the house located at 69 Chase Avenue that was partially destroyed by fire.

The demolition of this home was a necessity because the building was no longer structurally sound. The Building Inspectors Office solicited three quotes and awarded the project to Berkshire County Construction. The owner of the home did not have insurance on the property. A lien will be placed on the property for the cost of the demolition.

In addition to the fire there had been a number of other incidents on Chase Avenue. I asked the City Administrator and officials from the Police, Health, Building and the Community Development Office to visit the area in order to assess current conditions. A visit was made in early July and because of that visit we are working with the residents of Chase Avenue in order to clean up the area. The Health Department has procured a dumpster that will be used to remove debris located on the avenue and the work will be done and is being coordinated by residents of Chase Avenue themselves. City officials have also identified two empty buildings that will be high priorities in regard to our continual efforts to remove dangerous or blighted building located in our neighborhoods.
