Dear Sir:

We are the attorneys for William G. McKnight, Jr. and Irving Trust Company, as Trustees of a so-called "Charitable Trust" created by the late Edward R. Tinker by agreement dated July 29, 1957. The trust was established with a token amount only and has been inactive for over twenty years. As a result of the recent death of Mr. Tinker's widow, however, a trust created under Mr. Tinker's Will has terminated which will result in substantial funds being transferred to the Charitable Trust.

Enclosed herewith is a copy of the Charitable Trust deed from which you will note that your city will be entitled to receive annual income of \$4,000 out of the first \$9,500 of income.

You will note that the deed specifies that the income paid to the City is to be used exclusively for the maintenance or operation of the Hillside Cemetery.

May 23, 1978

We should say that there may be considerable delay before the Charitable Trust will receive its full funding and consequently, the payment of any income will necessarily, also be delayed. In the meantime, however, in order to establish payment procedures will you please indicate the name of the individual to whose attention the income checks should be sent.




