


MOHAWK BIKE PATH: PICKING A ROUTE

Planning has been underway to identify a route for a bike path connection from North Adams to Williamstown (and beyond). A preferred route (shown in red) has been identified, as well as some alternative routes (in orange). What do you think?

1. Please share your opinions on which routes work best in the three sections.
2. Are there places that are important places to have a neighborhood connections to the trail?
3. Are there areas where amenities such as lighting, benches, river access for boating or fishing, or signs are important?

- Enhance flood chutes and river landscaping where the trail meets the river
- Possible trailhead for riverwalk/bikepath and the Cascades on Avon Street?
- A pocket park or rest stop here (near Protection Ave) would be a good addition
- People parking on both sides of the street during field use at Alcombright Complex may cause an issue for bike path
- Utilizing Barbour Street Extension past airport could keep the path away from State Street
- Connect schools, don't cross Route 2
