

On Friday's November 3rd, 17th, 30th & December 1st, 8th, Lisa Bassi (Certified Hatha Yoga, LV Chair Yoga, Curvy Yoga: Certificate: Basic, Intermediate and Clinical Herbalism, Reiki Master Usui Reiki) will lead a five-week series on ways to enhance wellness. The sessions will focus on YOGA, HERBAL MEDICINE & REIKI. Enhance your winter wellness!!!!!!!

YOGA 2 weeks: Build a personal yoga practice focusing on relaxation, flexibility and strength. You will practice together and discuss refinements for personal needs and preferences. Each student will leave with a written gentle practice they can do at home.

(Attendees should be comfortable sitting and standing.)

HERBAL MEDICINE 2 weeks: Discussions will address supporting your body through the cold winter and make some herbal medicines. The goal is to build an understanding of how to support your immune system and to have some things on the shelf that will help with colds/flu treatment. (During the class we will be processing herbs and cutting and preparing roots and vegetables.)

REIKI 1 week: Reiki for wellness. Students will receive an introduction to Reiki and experience giving and receiving this work. Reiki week will also include guided meditations and breath work designed to relax and balance the body and calm the emotions.
